Desert Blue Connect Services

Crisis accommodation for women & children: safe and supported short term accommodation for women and their children who are escaping family violence or at risk of being homeless as a result of a crisis.

Children's services: Therapy service for children ages up to 17, who have experienced exposure to family violence or sexual assault.

Sexual assault counselling: Free service to support adult who have experienced sexual violence either recently or historically.

Family violence counselling and support: Free services to support adults and children exposed to family violence including- counselling, advocacy and support, outreach service, local support coordinator, Intervention service through Barndimalgu Court.

Men's community intervention service: Specialist service for men who use violence and wish to stop, subject to meeting entry criteria.

Rural support services: Counselling for men and women across the shires of Morawa, Mingenew, Three Springs, Yalgoo, Carnamah, Coorow and Perenjori

Women's health program: Nurse consults for women's health issues (eg-STI testing, menopause, breast health), Individual women's counselling and Unplanned pregnancy counselling.
